The language should be English.

Papers shall be in Microsoft Word format, Times New Roman, 12pt, 1.5
and justified text alignment.

The length shall not exceed 27 000 characters with spacing including notes
and bibliography.

SUBMISSION OF TEXT:

TITLE

Authors (full name and surname)

Affiliation and e-mail address

Three keywords

Abstract of 150 words

Text

The inclusion of verbatim excerpts from other works will be quoted with
(" ") and in Roman (not italics) and their origin must be specified with the
appropriate citation. If you need to write in a language with a different
alphabet (e.g. Greek), you should avoid transliteration and if possible use
original characters (e.g. for Greek type, Super Greek).

GRAPHIC MATERIAL

Images, drawings, graphs and tables should be submitted only in JPEG or TIFF.

Resolution of images: optimal: 600 dpi: minimum: 300 dpi.

The images will be reproduced in black and white (except where colour is necessary).

The authors should recall the figures in the text (images, planimetries, graphs, tables, etc.) as follows: (fig. 1).

The caption should be in a separate Word file.

Example:

Fig. 1: Cittanello quarry (Rieti, Italy), general view (Photo: G. Restiano).

BIBLIOGRAPHY

Reference marks:

Please mention the name of the author in caps, the year of publication and the pages.

If there are between one and three authors, they should be separated with commas.

If there are more than three authors, please write the first author's name and then the abbreviated Latin expression *et al.* ('and others') in italics.

Examples:

GUTIÉRREZ 2009, 22-37.

PREVOSTI 2006, 25; PUCHE 2004, 28.

MACIAS, LÓPEZ 2006, 28.

PALET *et al.* 2008.

Each reference mark in footnotes should be recalled in the final bibliography.

Examples:

GUTIÉRREZ A. 2009: Roman Quarries in the Northeast of Hispania (Modern Catalonia). Institut Català d'Arqueologia Clàssica, Tarragona, 2009.

PENSABENE P. 2002: "Il fenomeno del marmo nel mondo romano", in M. DE NUCCIO, L. LUNGARO (eds.): *I marmi colorati della Roma imperiale*, Venezia, 3-68.

JÁRREGA R.: La villa romana del Mas d'en Gras, Institut Català d'Aqueologia Clàssica, Tarragona. [In press]
